Perazzo Meadows Restoration

Moderate/Easy – help with meadow restoration – seeding, mulching, planting willows.

Martis Wildlife Area trail revegetation

Easy/Moderate – seed and mulch rehabilitated trail, move trail, build fence

Merrill Valley Restoration

Moderate/Easy – help with meadow restoration – seeding, mulching, planting willows. **4WD access to site.**

All day (9am-3pm) 10yrs +

Truckee River Corridor

Moderate – Restore area along Truckee River downstream of Floriston. Shuttle bus from Granite Flat provided.

All day (9am-3pm) 15yrs +

Glenshire Boardwalk construction

Strenuous – build boardwalk to prevent meadow damage. Same location as Glenshire trail re-route project.

Little Truckee hill climb restoration

Strenuous – remove erosive route below Stampede Reservoir. Access site from across river, waders required. Trout Unlimited project.

Truckee River Clean Up

Moderate – remove old fencing along Truckee River across from Olympic Heights.

Half day (11am–3pm) all ages

Glenshire trail re-route

Easy/Moderate – re-route existing trail, re-vegetate old trail. Same location as Glenshire Boardwalk construction.

Tahoe Donner Erosion control

Moderate – help prevent erosion near trails.

Martis Wildlife Area trail revegetation

Easy/Moderate – seed and mulch rehabilitated trail, build fence

Half day (11am-3pm) 15yrs+

Sagehen Trail Clean Up

Moderate – clean up barbed wire along Sagehen Creek Trail.

Agreement, waiver, and release – must be signed by all volunteers

In consideration for being allowed to participate in Truckee River Day, I, the undersigned, on behalf of myself and my heirs and assigns, agree to waive any and all claims for damages arising as a result of my participation in Truckee River Day, and further agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Truckee River Watershed Council, the United States Forest Service, other landowners on whose property Truckee River Day activities may occur, and their respective officers, employees, and agents, from any loss, liability, damage, cost, or expense arising out of my participation in Truckee River Day. This waiver and indemnification agreement shall apply regardless of any negligence or carelessness of any person or entity. I give the Truckee River Watershed Council and the United States Forest Service permission to use, for publicity purposes, any photographs or video footage including my likeness which may be taken during Truckee River Day.
